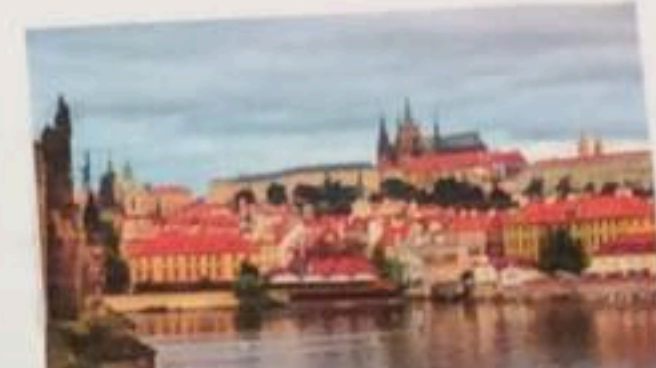

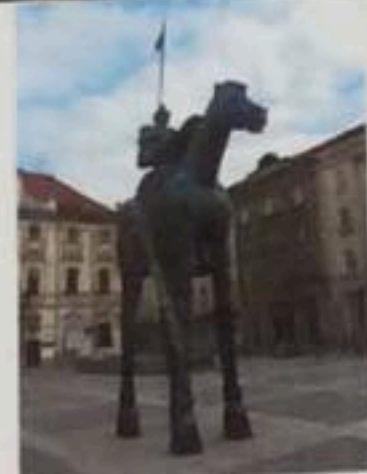

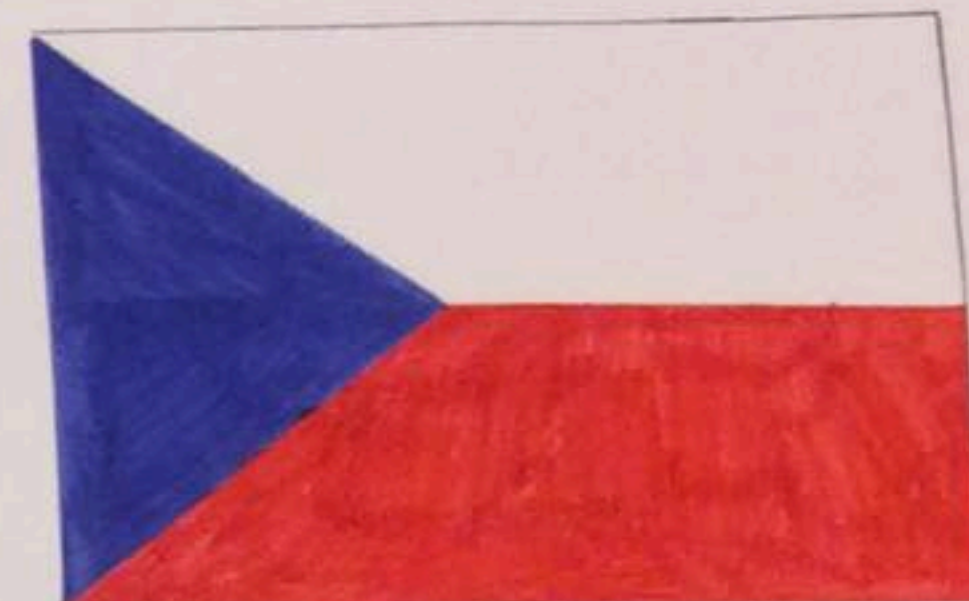

The town hall was founded in 1338. The Prague Astronomical Clock is located on the south side.



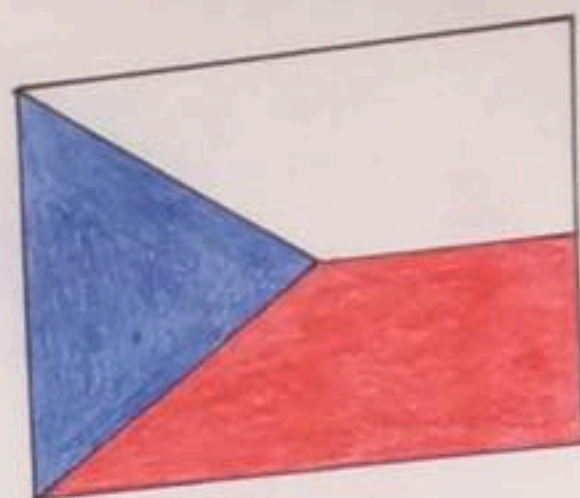
