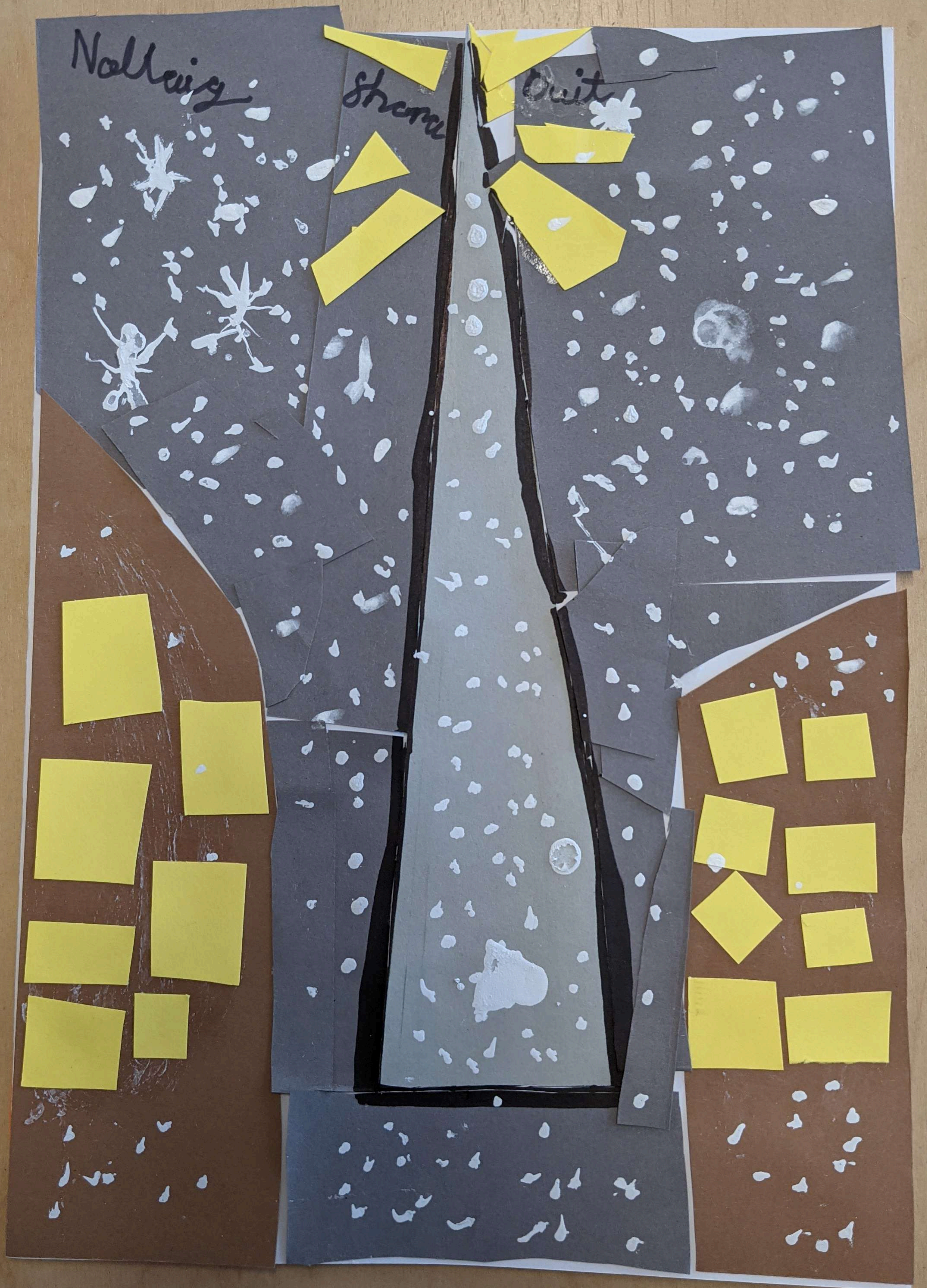

Nelson's Pillar. Ahaj!

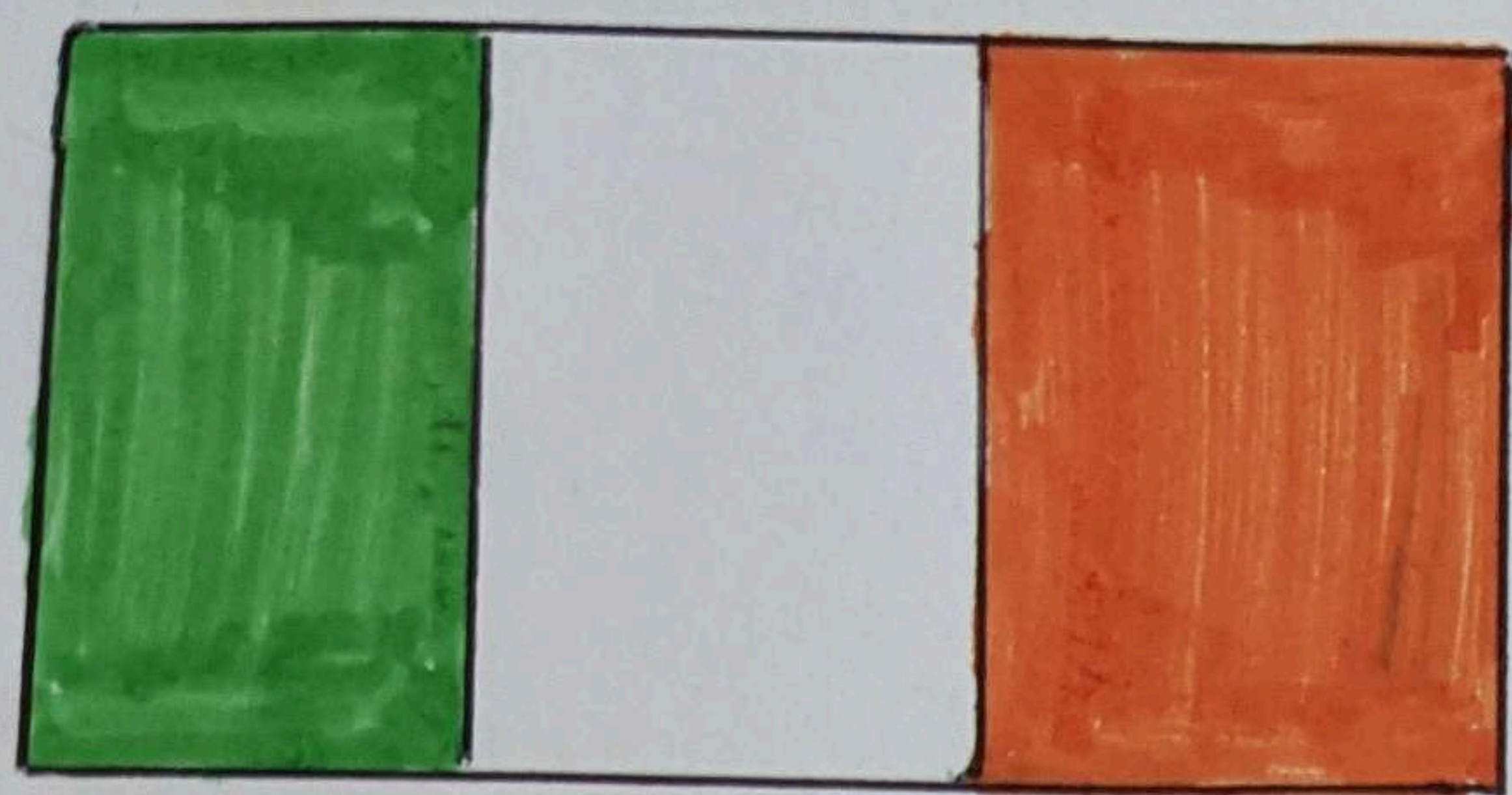
